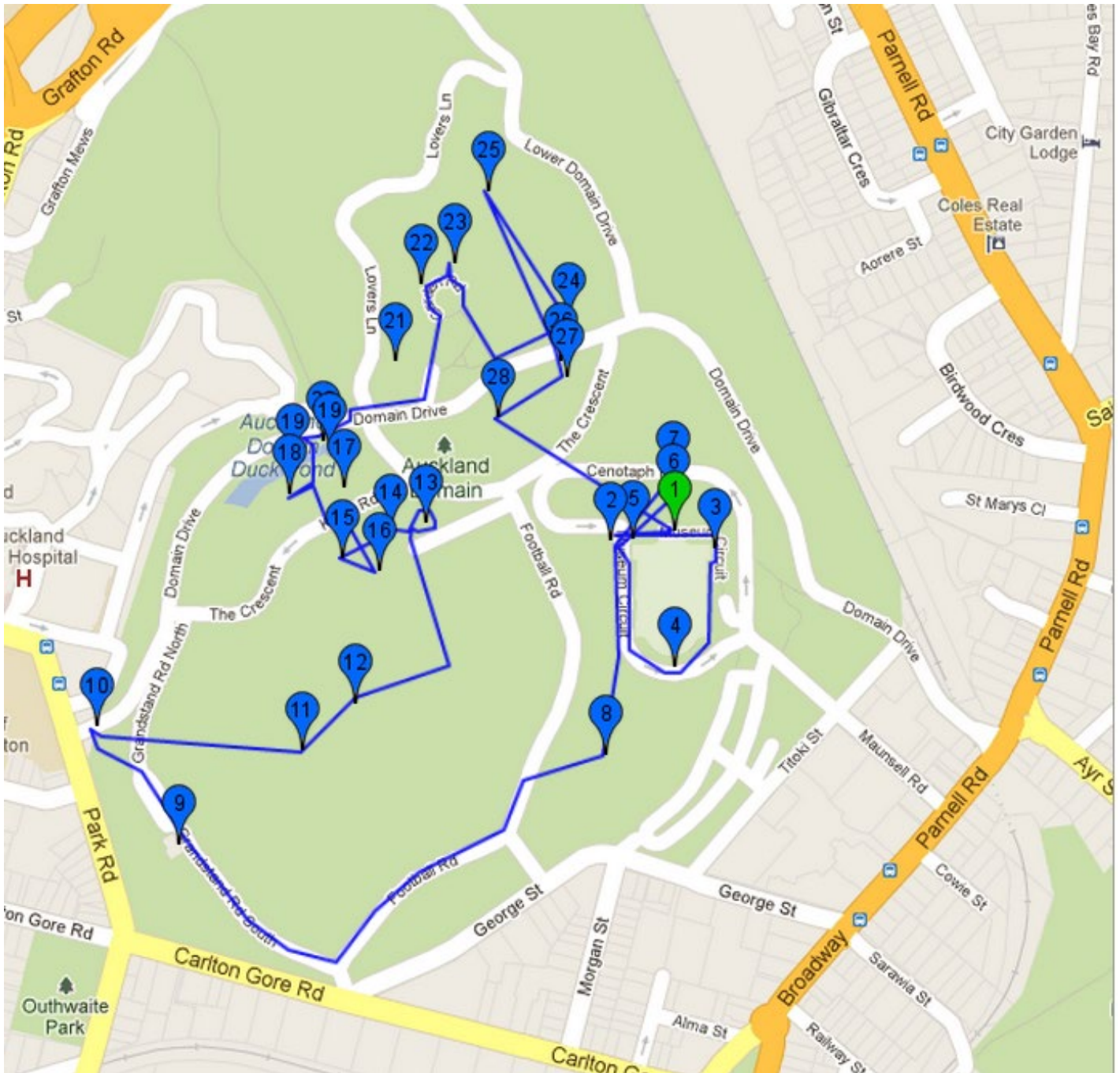


The Village Square Heritage Walks

This glorious park is richly endowed with sculptures and heritage buildings. Allow 2 hours for the walk.
