
## The Village Square Heritage Walks **Grafton**

Explore the suburb of Grafton in this 2.2 km walk. Extending from Symonds Street to the Domain and out towards Mt Eden, Grafton is perhaps best known for its bridge. The walk takes in one of Auckland's most significant cemeteries and provides background on residential and public heritage buildings. Allow 1.5 hours.
