
The Village Square Heritage Walks Streams & Gullies of Parnell

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Walk highlights

Take a 5.2km walk through the bush-clad gullies of Parnell. This walk links five separate reserves, including the foreshore of Hobson Bay. The walk requires an above-average to good level of fitness and good walking shoes are recommended! Not suitable for prams and buggies. Check tide charts and aim to take the walk close to low tide (see www.metservice.com/marine/tides/auckland). Allow 1.5 hours.
